Specific Responsibilities

The School Gardener, Maintenance Assistant, and Minibus Driver plays a crucial role in our organization by ensuring high standards of garden maintenance, building upkeep, and transport service, thereby supporting the overall environment and experience for our staff and pupils.

Gardening. This is the main focus of this role and will take up the majority of your time. There may be times, however, when the demands of the school require you to spend more time on maintenance tasks:

- Maintain and develop all flower beds to have all year round colour.
- Manage weed control and leaf raking.
- Plant and maintain seasonal pots and baskets.
- Work with hand tools and basic light machinery.



- Service all garden equipment and machinery.
- Maintain a clean garden by clearing rubbish and litter from the garden and grounds.
- Provide guidance to management on matters related to the garden.
- Report to the Estates Manager on gardening requirements and associated costs.
- Ensure a safe environment for staff, children and other school visitors by adhering to health and safety regulations.

Maintenance:

- Under the direction of the Estates Manager, carry out maintenance tasks as requested.
- Carry out occasional heavy manual work as instructed by the Estates Manager.
- Support the Estates Manager in the daily routine of the school as required and ad hoc tasks.
- Report any repairs required to the Estates Manager.
- Perform all tasks with the safety of others in mind.
- Attend in-house training and keep necessary skills up to date

Minibus Driving. This will be occasional cover if other staff are absent:

- Hold D1 entitlement on your driving license or be a trained minibus driver.
- Be able to drive the minibus on the school morning runs.
- Be able to drive the minibus to local schools to provide transport for sporting matches as and when required.
- Be able to drive the minibus for school trips as and when required.
- Provide car park security as and when required.
- Help at school events when required for car parking and security duties.
- Weekly minibus cleaning is required.
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Some flexibility in working hours may be requires at busy times of the year for the school.

As a School Gardener, Maintenance Assistant, and Minibus Driver, you will ideally:

• Possess the self-confidence, style, and communication skills necessary to effectively represent the school to both parents and staff.



- Have experience in garden maintenance, building upkeep, and transport services.
- Understand health and safety regulations related to your duties.
- Demonstrate exceptional time management and organizational skills.
- Exhibit excellent verbal communication skills.
- Work collaboratively as part of a team.
- Pay meticulous attention to detail.
- Maintain personal drive and energy and demonstrate the ability to see projects through to completion.
- Exhibit a proactive attitude, consistently going the extra mile and inspiring others to do the same.
