

Little Amesbury Fee Factsheet from September 2023 - Nursery Only

Please note that from September 2023, Nursery fees will be charged termly in advance and on a sessional basis.

Enrolment Fees

Registration Fee - £100

The Registration Fee is payable to enroll your child for the school and is non-refundable. It does not guarantee your child a place at the school.

Acceptance Deposit - £500

Once an offer of a place has been made by the school, receipt of the Acceptance Fee by the school guarantees your child's place. The Acceptance Fee is refundable when your child leaves the school, less any outstanding charges.

Funding

At Little Amesbury we are delighted to offer 30 hours of funded childcare per week during term-time to eligible families.

Eligibility to 15 hours of funded childcare is available to all.

Funding applies from the term after your child turns 3 years old (as they join our Nursery Class) until the term in which they turn 5 years old (in our Reception class).

Three hours of funding is applied to each session your child attends. A session is a morning (8.15am to 11.45am) or an afternoon (12.30pm to 4.00pm). To claim the full 30 hours funding per week your child must attend the setting for ten sessions (five days) per week. For all Nursery children there is now a lunch session from 11.45am to 12.30pm.

Children transferring from Nursery to Reception class continue to receive 30 hours of funding up to and including the term in which they turn 5 years old.

How Nursery operates

Here is what the day looks like in the Nursery setting (please note that this is a change):-

Early Birds (7.45am to 8.15am) £4.85 per day

Morning session (8.15am to 11.45am) £26.50 per day

Lunch session (11.45am to 12.30pm) £9.00 per session

Afternoon session (12.30pm to 4.00pm) £26.50 per session

Twilight session (4.00pm to 5.00pm – including hot tea) £12.00 per day

Twilight session (5.00pm to 6.00pm – after tea) £9.70 per day

A School Day is a morning session, a lunch session and an afternoon session and runs from 8.15am to 4.00pm.

Any child attending for a School Day will receive a 5% discount.

A **Full Day** is Early Birds, a morning session, a lunch session, an afternoon session and all Twilight sessions and runs from 7.45am to 6.00pm.

Any child attending for a Full Day will receive a 5% discount.

3 hours per morning or afternoon session is applied at a rate of £5.14 per hour or £15.42 per session or £30.84 per day up to your maximum eligibility.

Calculations for funded sessions:-

School Day charge (8.15am to 4.00pm)

with no funding £58.90 (2 sessions + lunch)

with 3 hours of funding £43.48

with 6 hours of funding £28.06

Full Day charge (7.45am to 6.00pm):

With no funding £84.12

With 3 hours of funding £68.70

With 6 hours of funding £53.28

Examples

- In a 10-week term, if a child attends for **3 Full Days** and is entitled to **30 hours** of funding, they will get 18 hours of funding. The cost to parents will be £84.12 x 3 x 10 = £2,523.60 less £92.52 x 10 = £925.20 = £1,598.40.
- In a 13-week term, if a child attends for **3 School Days** and is entitled to **15 hours** of funding, they will receive 15 hours of funding. The cost to parents will be £58.90 x 3 x 13 = £2,297.10 less £77.10 x 13 = £1,002.30 = £1,294.80.
- In an 11-week term, if a child attends for **5 Full Days** and is entitled to **30 hours of funding**, they will get 30 hours of funding. The cost to parents will be £84.12 x 5 x 11 = £4,626.71 less £154.20 x 11 = £1,696.20 = £2,930.51.
- In a 13-week term, if a child attends for 5 School Days and is entitled to 15 hours of funding, they will receive 15 hours of funding. The cost to parents will be £58.90 x 5 x 13 = £3,828.50 less £77.10 x 13 = £1,002.30 = £2,826.20.
- In a 10-week term, if a child attends for **4 mornings** and is entitled to either **15 or 30 hours of funding**, they will receive 12 hours of funding. The cost to parents will be £26.50 x 4 x 10 = £1,060.00 less £61.68 x 10 = £616.80 = £443.20.

Holiday Club

Holiday Club operates during all school holidays except for closures at Christmas, Easter and at the end of August/early September.

These closure dates for 2023/24 are as follows:-

- Monday 25 December 2023 to Monday 1 January 2024 inclusive
- Friday 29 March 2024 to Monday 1 April 2024 inclusive
- Friday 23 August 2024 to Tuesday 3 September 2024 inclusive

Charges are the same as for term-time sessions (as above). Surrey County Council funding does not apply.

Bookings can either be made for the academic year in advance or on a half-termly basis, with opportunities to book in advance of each half term and end of term.

Sessions are paid for in advance for each holiday period.
